### Sub: Morning School

It has come to the notice to the undersigned that a number of schools have already started in the morning shift in this pleasant weather however there is no provision to run the school in the morning shift in the academic calendar issued by the west Bengal Board of Secondary Education vide Memo no. D.S (Aca)/268/18/A/25/2, Date- 20.11.2018. Not only that if any institution runs in the morning shift the institution fails to fulfil their school hours as per Right to Education Act 2009 i.e 5.50 hours which is not acceptable as per rule in any way.

In this unexpected situation the undersigned has to instruct to all HOI (Secondary and Madrasah institution) to run their school as usual routine (Day Time) as they formed and submitted to the west Bengal Board of Secondary Education as well as to the undersigned as per academic calendar issued by the WBBSE until any order communicate to them from any authority concerned.
