ORDER

Whereas the offices of Pradhan of Gram Panchayat, Sabhapati and Sahakari Sabhapati of Panchayat Samity and Sabhadhipati, Sahakari Sabhadhipati and Karmadhyaskha of Zilla Parishad have been declared as whole time functionaries in terms of the provisions of sections 9,98,143 and 172 of the West Bengal Panchayat Act, 1973;

And whereas in terms of above provisions, during the period for which they shall hold or are due to hold such offices, they shall not hold such offices unless they have obtained leave of absence from the place of their employment or office of profit;

And whereas after being elected in the offices of full time office bearers, if they continue to hold any office of profit, they are liable to be removed from such offices in the Panchayats concerned in terms of sections 9(10), 98(9), 143(9),and 172(7) of the aforesaid Act.

Now, therefore, after careful consideration it has been decided by the Department of School Education that Office of the District Project Officers/ District Authorities of Sarva Siksha Mission under which Para Teachers are appointed in Primary /Upper Primary schools under Sarva Siksha Mission, shall, on receipt of application through their respective school authorities for lien /leave of absence from the Para Teachers concerned, allow them such lien

/leave of absence for their full term in the said offices in the Panchayats with effect from the date of their joining such offices so that such employment or holding of office of profit may not interfere with due exercise of their powers, performance of their functions or discharge their duties and that the public interest does not suffer.

It is further mentioned that the period While holding the full time post in Panchayat bodies and till the date of re-joining the post of para teacher in primary /upper primary schools their services as Para Teacher shall be treated as 'dies -non' and shall not be counted as the period of engagement for the terminal benefit after attaining the age of 60 years or any other benefit extended on the basis of years of service as Para Teacher.
