**Proposal for opening of school at Secondary / Higher Secondary level
from 12th February, 2021**

- Schools may be opened from classes IX to XII on and from 12th February, 2021.
- Academic classes for IX to XII may be held for each class everyday as per school hours in a week.
- Each IX to XII classes may be divided in two or more separate rooms depending upon resources available (class routine be accordingly adjusted) following social distancing and Covid-19 protocols among the students and staff of the school.
- Besides theoretical classes, the practical classes of class XI and XII may be taken up by the school authority on opening of school from 12th February, 2021.
- IT MUST BE MENTIONED HERE THAT ALL SCHOOLS MUST BE PROPERLY SANITIZED, MUST MAINTAIN ALL COVID-19 PROTOCOLS DURING SCHOOL DAYS i.e. WEARING OF MASK FOR ALL STUDENTS AS WELL AS THE TEACHING AND NON-TEACHING STAFF OF THE SCHOOLS, SOCIAL DISTANCING etc. ALSO PROPER AWARENES MAY BE CREATED AMONG STUDENTS/GUARDIANS ABOUT NORMS OF COVID-19 PROTOCOL.
