You are aware that the entire West Bengal is going through heat wave like condition for lack of rain for days together except in Hill areas.

In the above circumstances, DIs of Schools (PE) are advised to take necessary steps locally, if required, to shift all day sessions in primary schools under District Primary School Council / Primary School Council and SSKs, to morning sessions where ever needed and possible. In case the shifting from the Day to the Morning Session is not possible, necessary precautionary steps at the school level to combat the heat wave in consultation with the Health officials in the locality, may be ensured for protection of the children in primary schools.

DIs of Schools (SE) may take similar steps for Secondary and HS schools under the control of School Education Department including MSKs without compromising intended teaching, take necessary precautionary steps at the school level to combat the heat wave in consultation with the Health officials in the locality. Suitable guidelines on heat wave as issued by Health & Family Welfare Department and Disaster Management Department, Government of West Bengal shall be followed.
